FEATURED CHAMPAGNE

Pierre Péters, "Cuvée de Réserve", NV - \$152

Camille Péters, around 1919, was one of the first growers of the Champagne region to decide to bottle wine under his own name. In 1932, at the ripe old age of 12, Pierre Péters, the eldest son of Camille, began to attend his first exhibitions alone and develop sales for his father's brand, and never looked back. He took over operations in 1944, and released his first vintage in 1946 under the "Pierre Péters" brand. The estate, now run by Rodolphe Péters, owns just over 19 hectares of sustainably farmed vineyards, all of which are primarily located in the Côte des Blancs, where the soils are chalky and Chardonnay is king. Their flagship Champagne, the "Cuvée de Réserve", is a Blanc de Blancs style made from 100% Grand Cru Chardonnay grapes.

FEATURED NAPA CHARDONNAY

Shafer, "Red Shoulder Ranch", Los Carneros,
2014 - \$108

In 1988, Doug and John Shafer purchased a new property in the cooler Los Carneros region of Napa Valley to grow their Chardonnay grapes. The vineyard is sustainably farmed, and its name "Red Shoulder Ranch" has a much deeper meaning than just a name. The name pays homage to the local Red-shouldered hawks that are key to these sustainable farming practices. Tall perches were erected for the hawks throughout the property, and the hawks rewarded the Shafers for this by keeping the population of vine-damaging gophers naturally under control. This allows for no rodent poisons to be used throughout the vineyard, keeping the vines and the soils healthy. Healthy vines=Healthy grapes, and these grapes are the key to the creation of a classically-styled, California Chardonnay

Pax is back! Pax Mahle started his eponymous brand in 2000 after years of working in the wine business. He created rich, full-bodied Syrahs from some of the best sites around California. In 2008, a rift in the partnership behind Pax Wine Cellars caused him to have to dissolve the brand for a short while, focusing his efforts on his new label, Wind Gap. The label change also brought a stylistic change in the wines to a more lean, restrained style. He re-launched the Pax brand in 2014, again showcasing Syrah from many of the best vineyard sites in northern California. "The Hermit" is made from 100% Syrah, with grapes sourced from all 5 of their Syrah vineyards.

Cayuse founder Christophe Baron ended up in the United States after stints in Champagne and Burgundy, looking for a vineyard site to plant Pinot Noir in the Pacific Northwest. As fate would have it, he ended up stumbling upon an orchard that had stones reminiscent of the vineyards of Chateauneuf-du-Pape, and just like that, the rest is history. He began buying up small parcels, treating them like the Crus of Burgundy, but planting Rhône varietals instead of Pinot. The No Girls brand is ironically overseen by Baron's assistant vigneronne, Elizabeth Bourcier, so girls are definitely allowed.

This was the exclamation of an experienced sommelier when he tasted Buglioni's first Ripasso wine in 2000. This incident gave birth to the name of this wine, "Il Bugiardo", which translates to "The Liar". This Ripasso process involves blending wine from partially dried grapes, and freshly vinified wine that has been "re-passed" over the leftovers from the production of Amarone. It creates a wine that is reminiscent of Amarone, but with a little more drinkability.
